Excellent SATs results!

Children in Year 2 have exceeded the 2013 national figures for their expected level of attainment (level 2b) in reading and maths; they have also matched national figures in writing!

Our Year 6 children have exceeded the national 2013 figures for the expected level of attainment (level 4b) in combined reading, writing and maths. They also exceeded the level 5 figures in reading and level 6 figures in maths!

The Year 6 figures in particular are a significant improvement on last year.

Well done to all the children and thank you to all the parents that have supported them. Full details will be available on the School website in September.

Another real 'plus' is our end of year attendance figure.

Although our target was 95%, we actually managed to achieve over 96%! Which is also well above the national average!
