The aim of our new curriculum is to link much of the work around a theme, which makes learning more exciting and purposeful.

Science

Our first science topic will look at animal and human bodies, skeletons and muscles. We will have a WOW session where the children can explore different animals' diets and teeth.

Music

From September to February half term, Year 3 will be learning how to play trumpets (lessons led by a specialist from the Music service).

English Work

In literacy we will learn the features of non-chronological reports. We will also read the book *Stone Age Boy* by Satoshi Kitamura. This book will give us the opportunity for lots of exciting

Religious Education

Our question this half term is: What do different people believe about God?

This half term our topic is: **Who first lived in Britain?**

This topic focuses on the Stone Age.

Modern Foreign Language

We will have weekly lessons learning to speak French. In this first term, we will learn how to greet each other and understand and say classroom instructions.

Mathematics

We will solve lots of problems using place value, addition, subtraction and multiplication. We will learn to read Roman Numerals and investigate time and measurement problems.
