Welcome back! We hope you all had a lovely half term. We have had a great first week back at school – the children have returned full of energy and enthusiasm.

Parents in school – achievement assemblies

There have been some questions as to when we might invite parents back in school for the achievement assemblies. We are definitely hoping to do this again soon, but feel that it would be hard to manage now so that everyone feels safe. We are trying to put systems in place so that parents and carers can attend one-off, specific events such as Carols by Candlelight (dates below), Nativity performances (dates below) and for individual year group evenings such as the Year 6 Peat Rigg residential information evening, but feel that regular attendance at achievement assemblies would be difficult to manage. Depending on the number of COVID cases we have in school each week, systems have to change in school regularly (e.g. Assemblies going from being 'live' to being online) and it is also difficult to manage numbers in attendance at achievement assemblies. This is why we can potentially manage one-off specific events but struggle more with achievement assemblies. I hope you understand and will support us in this.
