My maths

Your child will be issued with an individual password to access My maths at home. There will be homework set regularly on this so please encourage your child to go online.

Reading in Year 3

Please note that we do not issue reading records in Year 3 however we still expect children to read **daily** at home. Reading will be monitored during our Guided Reading sessions with all children reading with an adult during these sessions at least twice a week. Children are also encouraged to read a wide range of different genres so if your child only likes to read non-fiction books at home, please encourage them to read stories too. Please also encourage children to read newspapers, reports online and in print and as many different types of text as possible. It is also important that we build on the good reading achieved in Year 2. Please continue to ask your child questions about what they have read as this really builds upon their inference and deduction skills which we will be building upon this year.

Homework, Spelling and LBH

As in Year 2, the children will continue to receive a weekly spelling test. In addition, weekly My maths homework will be set as well as a weekly English challenge. You have already received our English challenges so children can work at their own pace over the half term, however, we will ask to see the challenges fortnightly.
