#### **PE**

PE will be on Tuesday afternoons (which will vary between indoor and outdoor depending on the weather). On Friday mornings, all the children in Year 4 will be going to swimming lessons at Shipley Pool.

Please ensure that your child has their PE kit with them on these days including a tracksuit for outdoor PE. In addition, can you ensure that they have their swimming kit on Fridays? Children need to have a pair of pumps in their PE bag to change into during the day if their shoes are wet. It would be very helpful if all clothes were labelled. An additional letter with regards to swimming kit will be sent home.

#### **Homework in Year 4**

**Maths:** We will be using MyMaths to set maths problems which the children will be given a specific time to complete. In addition we will start by giving children some times tables challenges to complete.

**English:** Your child should have brought home an English Homework book containing a series of homework challenges. We will look at this on a Friday afternoon but will not collect it in until the end of the half term, when we will award a prize to the best homework in each class. These need to be handed in by the 14<sup>th</sup> October so we have the opportunity to mark all work and find a winner.

**Spelling:** Every Friday, children will receive their spellings and will be tested on them the following Friday. The test will be carried out in the homework diary so that you can see how your child has done each week.
