### Science

Our new topic will be forces. We will then move on to 'Space' including the earth, sun and moon.

### Visits

### English Work

We will begin our new class text 'The accidental time traveller' and our formal writing outcomes will be based on this. We will also focus on the poem 'The Highwayman'. This will give children opportunities to use expressive language and to write a news report.

### Computing

We will be learning all about staying safe on the internet. We will look at music production and take part in a local authority competition 'Bradford's Got Cyber Talent'
