Dear Parent/Carer,

I would like to thank you all for your help and support in keeping your children at home where possible and working with them to continue their education.

The school remains open for the children of key workers who have no alternative but to send their children to Low Ash, and we are running a skeleton staff here while the remainder of the staff work from home. We are also delivering meals to some children who cannot make it into school for various reasons, so you may see the school minibuses out and about on their daily lunch runs.

We would like to thank you and the children for the positive response to the work set at home and appreciate how hard everyone is working in these difficult circumstances – I gather that some children have completed the work set in double quick time! The teachers are currently busy compiling extra information and work for you to use at home, which will be displayed on your class page of the website by the end of the week. Your parent rep will let you know when this is available. The teachers will continue to set work on Purple Mash and communicate as much as possible with the children through this. Y6 are also using Google Classroom as an extra means of setting work/ communication.

For your information, we have been asked to provide a defined space within our school for the children of key workers in other local schools so that they can run as a separate 'school within a school' while their building is shut or used for other means. This will be for a very small number of children who will come with their own staff and will be kept separate at all times from the children of Low Ash. As you will appreciate, it is important for us all to work together at times like these so we will do all we can to make this work safely and effectively for all concerned.

Thank you for your continued support, and we will keep updating you as much as we can whether your children are still in school or at home with you.
