Dear Parent/Carer,

This is to let you know that the information for each year group that I mentioned in my last letter is now available on our website. The teachers have prepared a range of suggestions and ideas, but please remember that this is a 'menu' of activities to choose from and that your child does not have to complete everything by any means. Not all of the activities are on the computer which should help if siblings are trying to share iPads etc. at home.

I have been asked by Bradford Council to make you aware of a scam email being circulated regarding free school meals.

'Free School Meals Scam SCAM EMAIL – Free School Meals

*It appears that a number of scam emails are circulating stating: **if your child's school is closed and your child is entitled to free school meals; then to send your bank details to the school and they will help you with funding while schools are closed.** The links are fake and vulnerable families may be giving their bank details online so please ensure any service users you still have contact with are aware. Schools have been giving out vouchers to parents whose children qualify for free school meals, if you or anyone you have contact with has given their bank details to anyone in regards to this, please report it as soon as possible.'*

As you know, we are delivering meals where necessary, so we are not issuing vouchers at all. If you receive anything similar to this, then it will be a scam email, so please be careful.

The school remains open for the children of key workers who have no alternative but to send their children to Low Ash, and you may have seen some lovely photos on the school Facebook page of the children who have been working in the garden this week.

As I said before, we have been asked to provide a defined space within our school for the children of key workers in other local schools so that they can run as a separate 'school within a school' while their building is shut or used for other means. We have a small number of children from High Craggs Primary starting with us on Monday. This will be for a very small number of children (probably around 6 or 7 a day) who will come with their own staff. They will have an allocated classroom and their own separate facilities and will be kept separate at all times from the children of Low Ash. As I'm sure you will appreciate, we will do everything possible to make this work safely and effectively for all concerned. There are no other schools that we know of that are currently expecting or asking to join us here.

Thank you for your continued support, and we will keep updating you as much as we can whether your children are still in school or at home with you.
