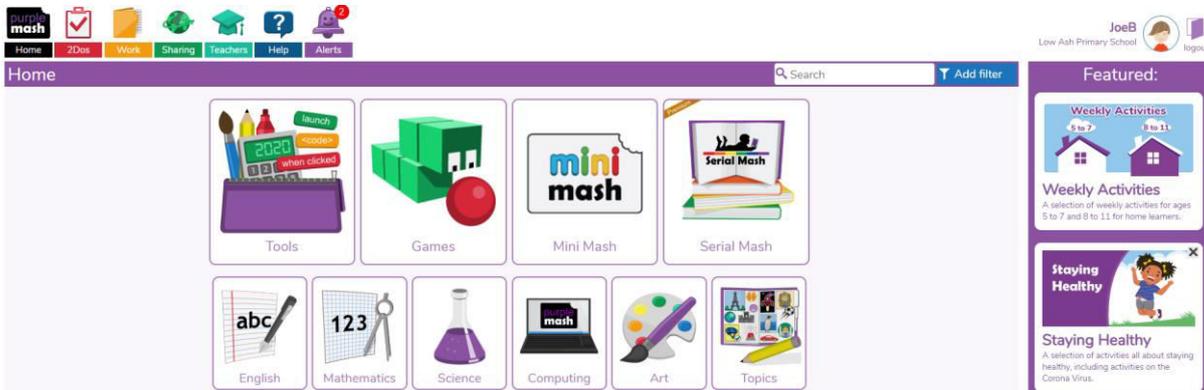
This letter will direct you to some more useful websites and explain in more detail the work set on Purple Mash in the weeks to come.

In addition to the 5 weeks' worth of work sent home, we will start adding more '2Do' tasks on Purple Mash. Your children already have their passwords and it has been great to see how many children are already engaging with the platform. These tasks are not time-sensitive and can be completed at your leisure.

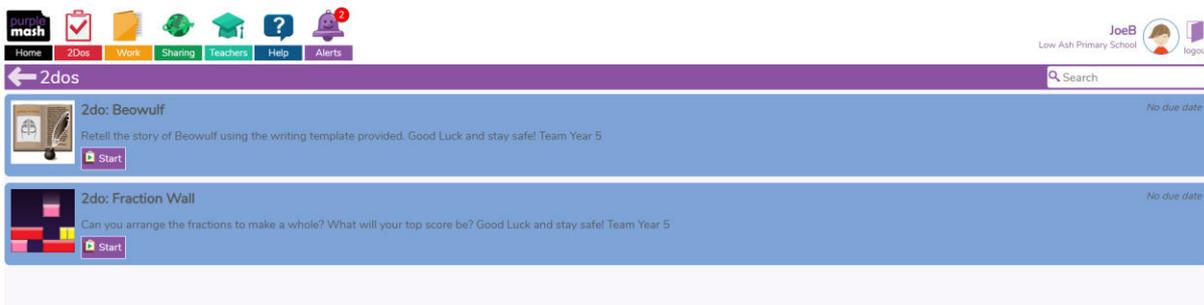
Regarding the use of PurpleMash, please read the following pieces of information as we hope this will provide some clarity for you and your children:

2Do Tasks

These are the tasks that are set for your child to complete online. They can be accessed via the red '2Do' button in the top left hand corner of the Purple Mash homescreen. Once clicked, a drop down menu will appear with a list of activities for your child to complete.



The red 2Do button can be accessed from the top left hand corner of the screen.



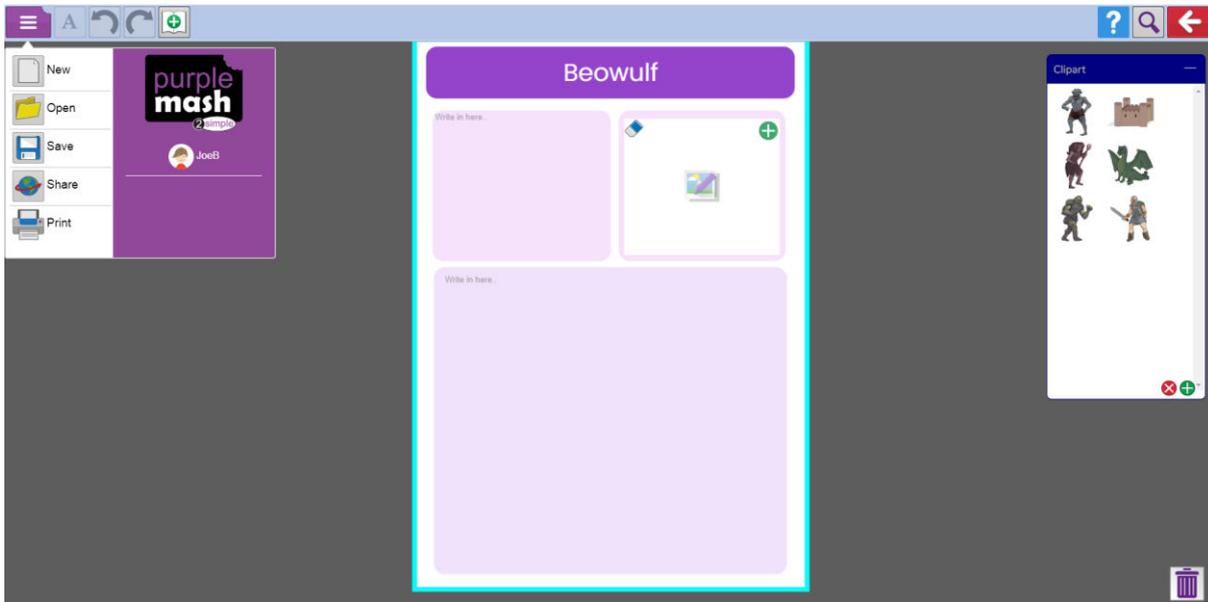
Once clicked, your child's 2Do tasks will appear below in blue. They will turn green once completed.



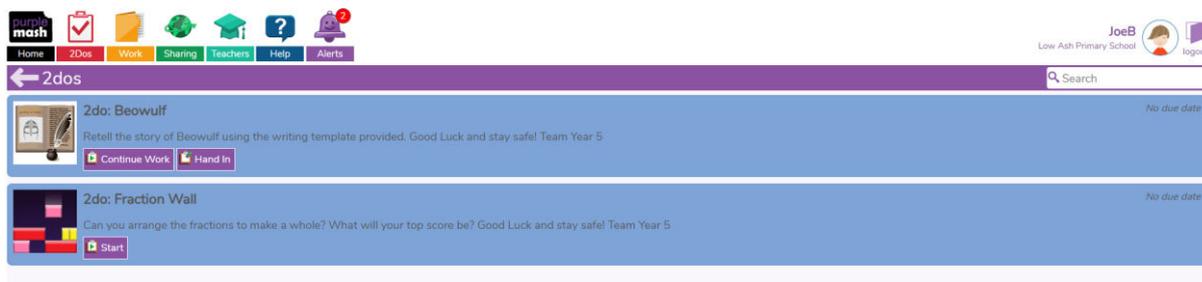

Handing work in



Children are able to save their work at any time by clicking the three horizontal lines in the top left hand corner of the screen. Once clicked, there is a 'save' option. The work automatically saves as their own name.



Once a piece of work has been saved, a 'Hand in' button will appear next to the 2Do task. Children must click 'Hand in' in order to submit their work. Please note, this should only be done once they are happy that their work is complete. The task will turn green to show that it has been handed in.

2Do Frequency

We believe that during this period of time at home, your child's wellbeing is of utmost importance. Whilst we are keen for him/her to use these online resources, we are also conscious that this should be balanced with time spent outside and a wide range of additional activities. Therefore your child can expect to receive no more than three separate Purple Mash activities per week. This will typically include a writing based task as well as one or two tasks that link to the wider curriculum.

We understand that there will be varying levels of participation and general accessibility to the online tasks we are setting for our pupils. Whilst we will encourage and monitor participation and engagement in Purple Mash, we understand that some children may be learning at home in other ways.

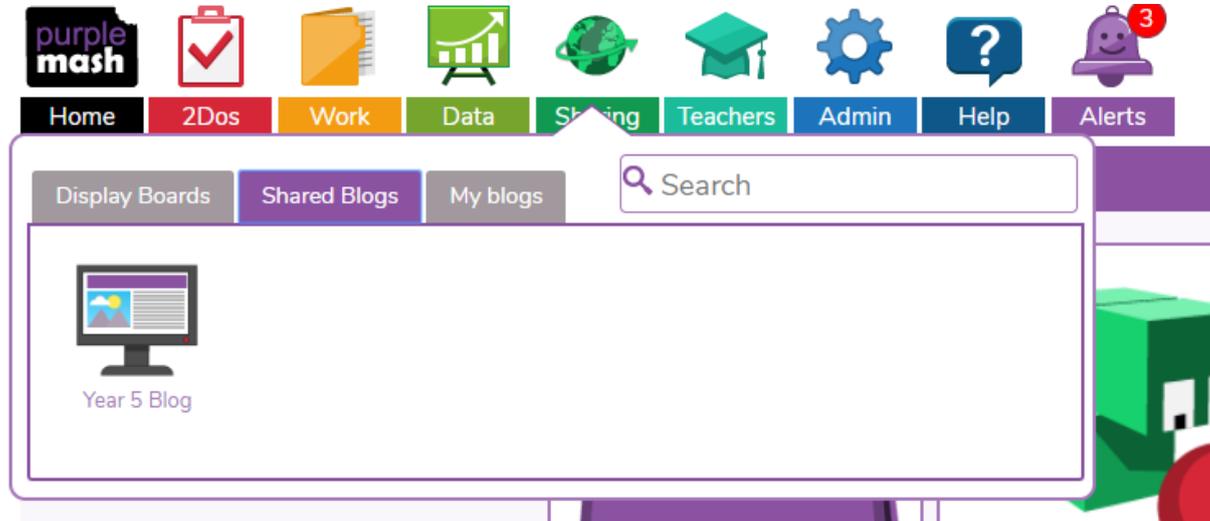


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Communication

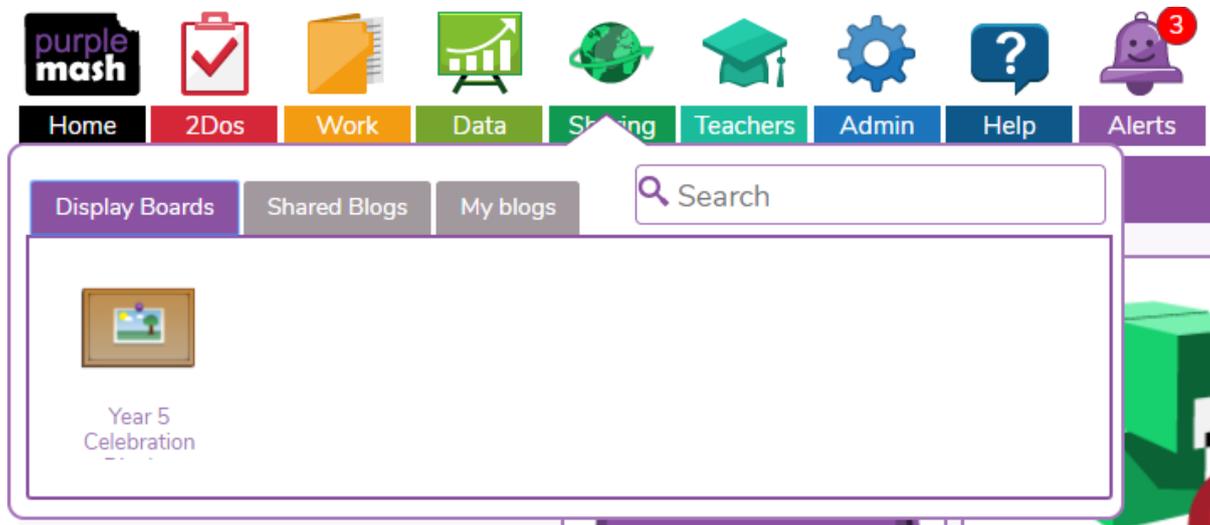

Please note, the Year 5 team will endeavour to respond to your questions and queries as soon as possible. We thank you in advance for your patience and understanding regarding this.

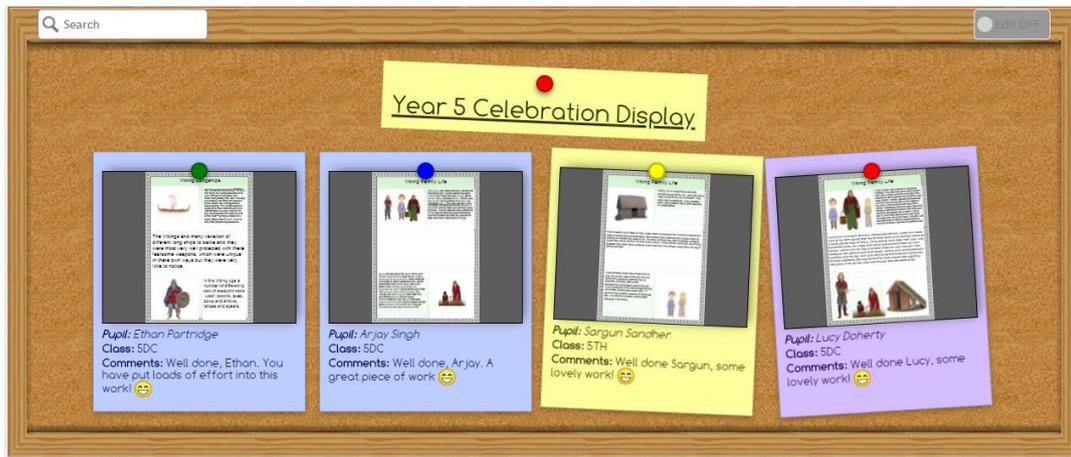
Celebrating Achievements
