Dear Parent/Carer,

As we start the new term next week, the teachers will be in touch via letter to make contact with the children and to give some more ideas and plans for work during the coming weeks. Please do feel free to ring or email school if you would like to leave a message for your child's teacher for further help or clarification. The teachers are in school on a rotational basis, so will be more than willing to contact you at any point.

Thank you for your continued support, and we will keep updating you as much as we can whether your children are still in school or at home with you.
