# Marshmallow Glitter

## Edible Playdough Recipe

### You will need:

- 6 marshmallows
- 3 tbsp cornflour
- 2 tbsp coconut oil
- 50g granulated sugar
- Red food colouring gel
- 2-3 drops of water

### Method

1. Put the sugar in a bowl and add a tiny amount of food colouring gel. Add 2 or 3 drops of water and mix together. Leave the sugar to dry for an hour.
2. Put the coconut oil and marshmallows in a microwave-safe bowl and heat for 30 seconds, until the marshmallows melt.
3. Remove the bowl from the microwave, add the cornflour and a tiny drop of red food colouring gel. Mix together with a spoon.
4. Once the ingredients are cool enough, knead the dough together with your hands.
5. Roll the playdough in the coloured sugar.
