<p>Monday</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Topic</p> <p>Talk about desert islands. What do they look like? Have a look on the internet to see what you can find out about them. What would you see? What would you like on your desert island?</p> <p>Activity: Make a desert island using drawings/pictures of items you would find on a desert island.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>How many maths-related nursery rhymes can you sing? <p>Tuesday</p>	<p>Watch the story of Llama finding a message in a bottle. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Oj6uqahSxb8 (you may need to watch further episodes).</p> <p>Talk about what they were doing – cleaning up the beach. What do you think was in the bottle? Where do you think it came from?</p> <p>Activity: Make a message in a bottle.</p>	<p>Make a chart (like the one below) to show what food you like to eat and what you don't like. Draw the food on your chart and count up how many things are on your chart.</p>	<p>Make an instrument using a plastic bottle and pasta. Put the pasta in the bottle and pop the lid back on. Play a tune with your new shaker. See what other instruments you can make using anything you can find.</p>
<p>Wednesday</p>	<p>What is a fossil? Where do you find them and how are they made? Explain how fossils are the remains of plants and animals that lived millions of years ago. Over time they have been squashed by soil and mud and have turned into stone. The shapes of these plants and animals can be seen in the stone. These are called fossils. See what you can find out about fossils.</p> <p>Activity: See if you can find a shell and print with it using paint.</p>	<p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0839o927XhA Watch the Peppa Pig clip about shapes. Make some triangles, circles, squares and rectangles out of coloured paper or card. Make a picture using the shapes and stick them to a piece of paper.</p>	<p>Baking today – what can you make? Cupcakes? Cornflake buns? Rocky road? Biscuits? Pizza?</p> <p>Take a picture of anything you make and put it on the WhatsApp group.</p>
<p>Thursday</p>	<p>Research what the beach and sea look like.</p> <p>Activity: Make a large picture of the beach and sea, then dip your feet in some paint and walk along the beach making footprints.</p>	<p>Find a tape measure and use it to measure lots of things around the house. What have you measured? Which is the tallest? Which is the smallest?</p>	<p>Make a suncatcher. Cut out the centre of a paper plate, put tracing paper in the centre and decorate it with watercolour paints.</p>
