<p>Monday</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Topic</p> <p>Read the following story book and talk about the treasure that the boy finds. Where has it come from? Who do you think it belongs to?</p> <p>Activity: Begin to make a treasure box using either a box or an egg box. <p>Tuesday</p>	<p>See what you can find out about pirate treasure.</p> <p>Activity: Make some treasure for your treasure box. What can you use? Have a good look around the house to see what you can find.</p>	<p>Make some s, a, t, p, l, n cards and play the s, a, t, p, l, n swat game</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=l0rvUHDZM3g</p>	<p>Find someone to sit opposite, put your feet together and hold hands. Now sing the song 'row, row, row your boat'.</p>
<p>Wednesday</p>	<p>Read a pirate story and dress up as a pirate – have fun, take some pictures.</p>	<p>Make some number cards 1 to 10 and play a similar game to the swat game with your adult.</p>	<p>Make some porridge - Explain that you are going to make some porridge and ask the children what ingredients will be needed. Look at the porridge oats, milk, water and talk about the difference between solids and liquids. What do the children think will happen when they mix the oats into the milk and water? Let them investigate with bowls and spoons in the water tray. What else do they need to do to turn the mixture into porridge? Let them watch as you heat up the mixture, stirring all the time, and allow the porridge to simmer for four minutes. Serve with different toppings.</p>
<p>Thursday</p>	<p>Do some research about pirates. What do they look like? What do they wear?</p> <p>Activity: Design your own pirate. Will he have a beard? What will he look like?</p>	<p>Play Kim's game with an adult. Find some things beginning with s, put them on a tray and cover them up. Get your adult to show you quickly the items then cover them. See how many things you can remember are on the tray.</p>	<p>Make some treasure for you to find on your treasure hunt tomorrow.</p>
