## Just for fun Ideas

<p>Monday</p>	<p><u>Ocean in a box</u> Find an old box (a shoe box is perfect). Paint the box blue or stick on blue paper as your background. Draw and design underwater creatures that can hang from the top of the box with string. Can you add green paper to make it look like seaweed too?</p>
<p>Tuesday</p>	<p><u>Toilet roll octopus</u> Paint your toilet roll and leave to dry. Carefully make 8 cuts around the bottom of the toilet roll to make the legs. Add 2 googly eyes. You could even make an octopus family! <p>Wednesday</p>	<p><u>Sensory Spaghetti</u> Cook the spaghetti as instructed. Separate into 2 food bags. Add a couple of drops of food colouring into each (blue &amp; green). Squish around to mix the food colouring. Rinse the spaghetti to get rid of excess food colouring. Put the spaghetti in a bowl and mix up your ocean. Could you add some shells or fish?</p>
<p>Thursday</p>	<p><u>Ocean foil painting.</u> Cover a piece of card in foil. Add blobs of dark blue, light blue and white paint onto the foil. Use a cotton bud to create swirls and waves on the foil. Leave to dry. Draw different types of fish on paper, cut out and add to your underwater scene!</p>
<p>Friday</p>	<p><u>Calming wave machine (in a bottle)</u> Fill a 1/3 of a bottle with water. Fill up the rest with oil. Add a couple of drops of blue food colouring and a handful of sequins or little shells if you have any. Seal with tape or glue. As the oil and water do not mix, when you shake the bottle, you will create waves inside! (you could even add an Alka Seltzer to make more bubbles!)</p>
