Dear Parent/Carer,

We have been delighted with the children's return to school after the Easter holidays – they have come in looking bright and enthusiastic and have settled back into school well. Thank you for your help and support with this.

As you are aware, the new set of after school clubs are due to start next week. It has been a bit of a staggered start for the clubs, but we think you will agree that the 19 clubs that will run each week will provide the children with the best club offer we have had yet, ranging from the Low Ash Bake-Off for Reception children to the Samba Band for Years 5 & 6, and some new sports clubs as well as many well-established favourites.

Please remember that Parent Consultation Evenings will take place next week on Wednesday 21st and Thursday 22nd April (6LH's take place on Tuesday and Wednesday). If you haven't yet made your appointment, the booking system is available on our website and you will automatically be provided with a link to your virtual appointment with your child's teacher. It is the first time that we have tried this system, but it seems easy to use and efficient, so hopefully will go smoothly. We are definitely all a little more used to working online after our recent period of remote learning!

Our Walk to School initiative has started this week and it has been lovely to see so many children walking, cycling or scooting to school. The children will find out on Monday which class is in the lead for this so we're sure there will soon be some healthy competition! To recap, the idea is that the children are encouraged to walk, cycle or scoot to school at least once a week, with the option to park a minimum of 10 minutes' walk away and to walk, cycle or scoot in from there. The children who manage this at least once a week for a calendar month will receive a small reward in school, with classes encouraged to compete against each other to have the most children taking part in this 'Walk to School' initiative.
