Welcome back! We hope that you had a great half term break.

As you may be aware, our Learning Challenge this half term is continuing from last half term. We will be covering more about the Vikings and Anglo Saxons, looking at some of the rulers and what legacy they left. In our Science lessons, we will also be continuing to learn about animals and their habitats. We will be revisiting what a habitat is and what food chains are. We will also be investigating how habitats can change due to humans and whether these changes are positive or negative.

Maths

This half term our focus will be on:

- revising place value and the four main operations
- looking at recording data linked to sports days
- revisiting how to divide and multiply numbers by 10 and 100

English

We will be looking at a book called 'Viking Boy'. We will be using all the skills we have learnt this year to write our own narrative and continue to up-level our vocabulary and punctuate our work correctly.

PE

PE is Wednesday afternoons and we will be focussing on rounders and athletics. Please ensure that your child has their PE kit with them on these days including suitable outdoor sports footwear. Children need to have a pair of pumps in their PE bag to change into during the day if their shoes are wet. It would be very helpful if all clothes were labelled. On Friday afternoons we will be learning all about Handball, which is a new sport for us!

Homework in Year 4

Maths: Children will have homework every Friday which consists of MyMaths and/or sheet of maths problems if appropriate.

English: Your child should have brought home a homework book containing new challenges. Children will have to read some books from the Rising Stars website. These are the appropriate book band for the children.

Reading: Children should be reading aloud to an adult on a daily basis to help them gain fluency and confidence with their reading.

Spelling: Every Friday, children will receive their spellings and will be tested on them the following Friday. The test will be carried out and sent home so that you can see how your child has done each week.
