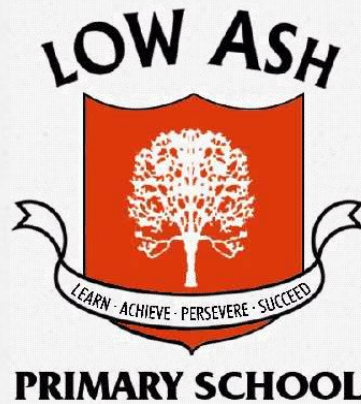


Welcome to Nursery

Key Person

Your child will be allocated a key worker for the year.

To help them settle and encourage home/school links.

The class teacher will also oversee *all* children.



Drop off and Pick up

Afternoon session 12:15pm - 3:15pm

Full Session 8:30am - 3:15pm

Drop Off

- Morning session starts 8:30am
- Afternoon session starts 12:15pm

Pick up

- Doors open 11:25am (AM children ONLY) and 3:05pm
- Please wait at the gate and a member of staff will open the it when the children are ready to go.

Please let a member of staff know if someone else is picking your child up or ring school if you are delayed.

Daily Routine

- Arrive in Nursery and carry out a child led activity
- Short adult led group activity
- Opportunity to play inside or outside. Get involved in challenges within the setting
- Final carpet session before home time.
- Lunch time for full time children 11:30-12:30pm

Outdoor Play

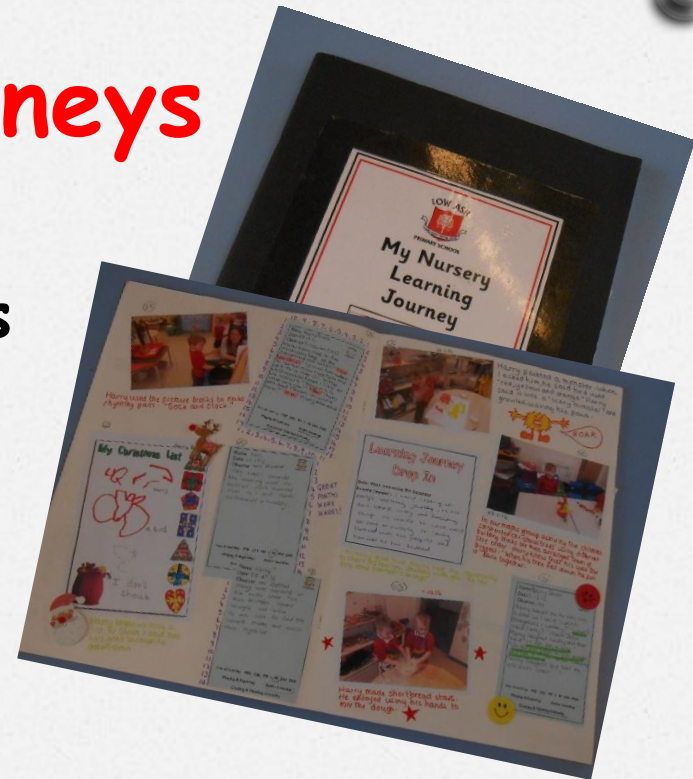
We have an excellent outdoor area

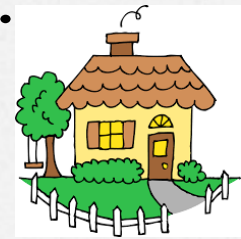

Home Visits

Home visits are proven to help settle a child. It is an opportunity for your child to meet their new teacher in their own environment, where they feel more relaxed.

A member of staff will call you shortly, please arrange a visit then.
They will take place 3rd, 6th and 7th September.



Transition

Information

Please inform your child's class teacher when they phone you of the name you wish your child to be called, if it is different from our records. Please also inform them of any medical and dietary needs.
