The aim of our curriculum is to link much of the work around a theme, which makes learning more exciting and purposeful.

Science

We will be learning about forces

French

We will be learning to use vocabulary and sentences linked to aspects of school life.

Visits

As part of our Victorian topic we will host a Victorian classroom and visit the church for Victorian Christmas on the **9th December**.

English Work

Much of our English work will be linked to the "Just So" stories of Rudyard Kipling. The children will create their own "Just So" story. We will also be reading the text Street Child and will write diary entries in the perspective of a character.

Creative Carousel

In carousel we are looking at still life and printing; protest art and cams and mechanisms.

Religious Education

This term the topic is:
Why are places sacred?

This half term our topic is:
How did Victorian society change as a result of the Industrial Revolution?

PSHE

We will be revisiting the Y4 curriculum and looking at puberty. Following this, we will move on to physical wellbeing.

Mathematics

We will concentrate on the four number rules and solve problems. We will then move onto measurement and statistics.

History

We will be learning about the Victorian era including school life for children; working and living conditions and key historical events such as: the Factory Act and the Industrial Revolution.

Computing

As part of the computing curriculum, we will be learning how to create and use spreadsheets using Purple Mash.
