

Nat West Money Sense Workshops



At the end of the November, years 1 – 6 were visited by teams of volunteers from Nat West Bank who led a series of 'Money Sense' workshops. For the younger pupils (years 1 -3) these helped build an understanding that there are choices with what to do with money and that money can be spent, saved or donated. Discussions were also had around the

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differences between wants and needs and, finally, pupils considered the different ways in which a family might spend their money.

Years 4 -6 spent their sessions identifying what would make a good birthday party and then planning and organising one within a set budget. They had to identify costs and, by the end of the session, were showing a real understanding of value for money.
