#### <u>Science</u>

This half term we will be learning about the needs of humans and animals, considering how they grow and change and reflecting on a healthy diet and lifestyle. We will link our learning into the work of Florence Nightingale by linking this to cleanliness.

#### <u>History</u>

When learning about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole we will study primary and secondary sources. We will ask questions about artefacts and consider the feelings of people alive at the time. We will make comparisons with modern medicine and the work of nurses today.

**Mathematics** 

- Problem solve and explain our reasoning.Continue to understand multiplication and division
- Continue to understand multiplication and division facts from the 2, 5, 10 times table.
- Starting to count in multiples of 3.
- Look at multiplying two numbers together.
- Look at dividing .

We will:

• Continuing to solve fact families, especially those relating to the 2,3,5 and 10 times tables.

**<u>RE</u>** We will be looking at what is special to different faiths and to us.

## <u>PHSE</u>

We will be looking at how to keep healthy and have a healthy diet. We will also look at what germs are, how they spread and how to avoid catching poorly because of them.

#### <u>Computing</u>

In Year 2 we are learning to be online researchers. We will be using the internet to learn about effective and safe ways of conducting research. We will learn to use search engines and even conduct voice searches!

### <u>English</u>

This half term we are reading the Magic Faraway Tree by Enid Blyton. We will explore the language she uses in her stories and use similar examples in our own writing about an enchanted wood. As a stimulus for our writing, we will be visiting some local woods.
