Our Learning Challenge this term is 'Brave People'. It has a history focus, giving children the opportunity to develop their enquiry skills and ability to question and compare. We will evaluate sources and empathise with key characters. We will begin by studying the actions and impact of the 19th Century nurse Florence Nightingale. We will think about:

- Why she wanted to become a nurse.
- What her family thought about her becoming a nurse.
- Who she helped and why.
- What impact she had on medicine as we know it today.
