Year 3 - Summer Half Term 1 Parents' /Carers' Leaflet

Mathematics

Fractions: Splitting shapes objects and numbers into fractions including halves, thirds and quarters as well as adding fractions with the same denominators.

Money: We will learn to count money (up to £10), make amounts of money in different ways then we will add and subtract amounts of money.

Values

Our value this half term is Liberty.

Science

We will learn about sources of light, how light travels, what are reflectors of light, how shadows are made and how to stay safe in the sun.

Geography

We will be exploring the human and physical features of the Yorkshire Dales. We will look at OS maps of the Yorkshire Dales and discuss the symbols used on these maps as well as finding locations and facilities of maps using 4-figure grid references.

English
