### What are we learning this half term...

We will be focusing our learning around people who help us.

We have had a mind mapping session to help us think about all the different people who help us during the day, from our parents/carers and teachers to shop keepers, fire fighters, Doctors and garage mechanics.

Please talk to your child about people who help them and talk about what you do for a living if you are working. If anyone has a specific trade and would like to come and talk to the children about how they help others, please come and chat to one of the Nursery team.



### Maths

As usual we will be singing lots of number songs, counting and working on our 1:1 correspondence counting. We will be counting to 5 then 10 and showing finger numbers to 5 then 10 (6 to 10 is tricky for some children). We will be exploring numbers 3 to 8 this half term, simple addition and positional language.
