Go for a short run within your local area. This could be around the edge of a field or park. It could also possible be through the woods. Try and find a circuit that will take you back to the start so you can time how long it took you. Can you beat your time second time round?	Design and create your own 3D model of a pyramid. Use different materials you have or can find to create your own pyramid. Think about: What will your pyramid be made of? Will you have anything inside it? Can we lift off the top to see inside your pyramid?	Choose a book that you have read this half term. Draw and write a wanted poster for the main character or the main villain in the story (if it has one). Think about: - The character's appearance - Explain why this character is 'wanted' - Explain where this character could be found Explain the impact the character has had on others.	Use our class text, Ma'at's Feather as your inspiration. Write a story about a poor Egyptian farmer who plans to rob the tomb of Tutankhamun. Structure your story: Introduce your character. Who makes the plan? Who does he/she plan with? How did he/she get into the tomb? What treasures did he/she take? How did he/she get out of the tomb? What did he/she do at the end of the story?
Go for a walk with your family and/or friends: Enjoy seeing the leaves grow as we say goodbye to Winter and welcome Spring. See if you are able to go for a walk somewhere you can see lambs being born as Spring is the best time to see this.	Sketch and colour a picture of the famous death mask of Tutankhamun which was discovered by Howard Carter in 1925.	Read and research the 'Curse of Tutankhamun': Create a list of things that happened that made people believe in the curse. Explain at the end. Do you think it is a curse from Tutankhamun or just coincidence?	Research Howard Carter and his discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun. Imagine you are Howard Carter and write a diary entry about the discovery. Think about: - How did you feel? - Who was first to discover something strange? - What worries did you have? - What was the first thing you saw?
Plant and grow a seed in a plant pot. The plant plot can be anything, even an empty can or tub. Monitor your seed as it germinates and grows. Draw pictures as it grows and eventually plant it in your garden or in the school garden where it can thrive.	Draw and colour the canopic jars which were used in the mummification process. Then label them with key information. Things to draw and label: - Draw and colour all 4 canopic jars Label each with the name of the canopic jar Explain which organ was placed in each canopic jar Explain why this was done.	Research and read about the mummification process. Read about: - What Egyptians believe happened after death? - What was the mummification process? - What was the 'Book of the Dead'? - What did Egyptians have to do to reach the 'afterlife'? - Why were Pharaohs buried with all their gold and other precious items?	Create a fact-file about the pyramids and/or the Valley of the Kings. Research and write about: - Where are the pyramids and the Valley of the Kings? - Why were they built? - When were they built? - What is the difference between the two? - How many people visit them each year? - How are they looked after today? - What was found inside them?
