Science

Our Science focus will be on animals including humans. We will be looking at the digestive system and teeth.

Music

We will continue to learn how to play the ukulele focusing on:

Can I put together my own improvised chord progression using the notes of the C scale?

Can I sing and perform a piece of music on the ukulele? Can I learn how to play the Am chord and recognise the difference between major and minor chords?

English Work

Our English work this term will be based around the text Saxon Tales—The King who Threw Away his Throne by Terry Deary. He begins the story with a great character description. We will use this to write our own character descriptions.

Religious Education

This term we will continue to learn how the Five Pillars guide Muslims. We are looking forward to a trip to a mosque in April.

History: Anglo Saxons

We are revisiting Britain at the end of the Roman Period and looking at who invaded and settled after the Roman legionaries left.

French
