The aim of our curriculum is to link much of the work around a theme, which makes learning more exciting and purposeful.

PE

We will be taking part in outdoor and adventurous orienteering as well as tag rugby.

Science

We will study evolution and inheritance, in particular how humans have evolved over time. We will also look at Charles Darwin's theory of natural selection.

French

We will be learning to talk about our own hobbies and pastimes as well as recap prior learning from Year 6.

Religious Education

We will look at how growing up brings responsibilities.

PSHE

We will be studying identity, society, equality and Human Rights.

This half-term's History focus :

Ancient Greece

The children will complete a study of Greek life and achievements as well as their influence on the Western world. The key enquiry questions for this unit are:
How were the Greek city-states different?
What was the legacy of Ancient Greece?

English Work

We will be writing newspaper articles based on current world affairs. We will also be writing a short piece of narrative based on surviving the Spartan Agoge.

Computing

This term we will be creating a 'Text Adventure story' based on choose-your-own-adventure books.

Mathematics

In sets, we will focus on algebra and measurement as well as aiming to increase our accuracy and speed in arithmetic.

Our Values

We will be focusing on our value of Democracy as well as looking at resilience.

In art, the children will be using portrait works of Picasso as inspiration for their own pieces. In DT, the children are designing and building. The final group will be working in the garden area.
