Dear Parents/Carers,

First of all, we would like to say how very proud we have been of all the children in Year 6 as they completed their SATs tests this week. Even when the tests were at times difficult, everyone took a deep breath and did their very best.

Next week, Year 2 will be sitting their end of year SATs. These are less formal, but still important tests for the children as they move up into KS2. As we said last week, Year 1 will have their phonics screening check week commencing 6th June, which is a government assessment to test the pupils' phonic knowledge. Children in Year 4 will then complete their Multiplication Tables check at the end of June, which is a government assessment to check knowledge of times tables.

We know that all the children across the school have worked extremely hard this year and will do their absolute best in all the above. We wish them all well.

It was lovely to have parents and carers back in school again this week for the Reception open session, Year 1 'Share a lesson' as well as the Achievement Assemblies.

Entrance Building Work

On a totally different note, we are pleased to be able to let you know that preparations for the final part of our building work are due to start next Monday. For those of you new to the school, our new Nursery building was completed in May 2020, and further work to our Reception classrooms was then finished in September 2020. This is the final phase of the building work and is a rebuild of our front entrance, with added office and meeting room space.

The work will start on Monday when a portacabin will be placed in the staff car park in the area in front of the KS2 pod. This will arrive early in the morning and be in place well before school starts. This will eventually form a temporary office and school entrance. The proper building work will start on May 23rd while we are on holiday, and the whole project is scheduled to be finished by December 5th.

We will update you next week on what to expect after the half term holiday!
