History

We will learn about when and where the Benin Empire began, and who the people of Benin were. We will also look at how Benin became an empire and how it declined and eventually fell.

Music

We will continue to learn the trumpet and practise for a performance at the end of the year.

English Work

We will be writing persuasive travel guides relating to countries in Africa.

Religious Education

This half term our topic is:
Why did the Benin Empire crumble?
Our Learning Challenge will have a history focus, looking at the key concepts of monarchy (The Oba) and war and conflict (The British Empire).
