Thank you so much for supporting our school book fair. The fair made a massive £1351 which meant that Low Ash was given £405 in commission to spend on books. These new books will go in our reading vending machine and be used as rewards for pupils.

### Food Bank

A further thank you those who donated to our Harvest Appeal. All donations went to the Bradford North Food Bank. In total Low Ash collected 183 Kg of food/toiletries worth approximately £320 This amount of food will make 15 x 2-person food parcels. As the cost of living crisis worsens, these donations are hugely appreciated and needed.
