Dear Parents / Carers,

Thank you to those who have filled out the short parent survey which was emailed out this week. We were delighted with the overall responses, which are as follows.

97% of parents would recommend the school to other parents.

96% of parents said that their child was happy at this school.

95% of parents said that their child could take part in clubs and activities at school.

93% of parents felt that they were kept informed by their child's class teacher.

96% of parents thought that the school was well-led and managed.

We will share some comments in due course as well as address specific issues raised.

Football Match

There have been many requests over the past few weeks for us to allow pupils to watch the first World Cup England football match on Monday afternoon. We have made the decision to swap the Friday enrichment afternoon of next week to Monday so that, those that want to, can view the match in school. Those pupils who do not want to will be taking part in enrichment afternoon activities (these may be slightly different to their normal enrichment activity). Then come along to the Fair and treat yourself to a new jumper - prices start at just £2, so much cheaper than the shops!



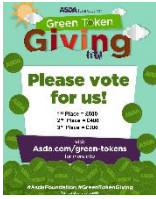
