Suggested challenges for your child to enjoy at home

Pick an expression of your choice. Create a portrait of this emotion using different materials (paint, crayon, chalk etc).



Find a poem that you enjoy and read it. Talk to your adult about the words that are used. Read the poem out loud and perform it for your family.



In English, we are reading *The Stone Age Boy*. Imagine you have entered the Stone Age and think about what you can see, hear and smell.



In History we are learning about The Stone Age to Iron Age period. Research some interesting facts.



Choose a character from your favourite book. Write a character description using a range of adjectives and expanded noun phrases.



Listen to a piece of music and talk about which instruments you can hear. Can you discuss the pitch, tempo, rhythm, dynamics and texture?



In Science we have been learning about different types of skeletons. Create a poster explaining the difference between an endoskeleton, exoskeleton and hydrostatic skeleton.



Help your adult to make a toastie sandwich using the skills you developed during creative carousel. Can you remember the instructions and make a list?



Using items you have at home, create your own board game. You can use any games you have played before to give you some ideas.
