<u>French</u> We will be learning to talk about our own hobbies and pastimes as well as recap prior learning from Year 6.	<u>Computing</u> We will be covering additional areas of Online Safety need using the 'ProjectEVOLVE' curriculum.
<u>Mathematics</u> We will continue our learning about fractions, decimals and percentages before moving on to algebra and then measures.	<u>English</u> We will be basing our first piece of narrative writing on the book 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna. We will also be writing persuasive leaflets all on South America.
