Your child will shortly be taking the end of Key Stage Two SATs commencing on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> May. Below is the timetable for the week, so that your child can be prepared accordingly.

The children have been working extremely hard in preparation for these tests and time is being spent in class to discuss any worries and concerns. The teachers are reiterating the fact that as long as your child tries their best then we shall all be very proud of them. All the papers will be marked externally, however, writing has been assessed throughout the year and so there will be no formal writing test.

When the children are not doing the tests, there will be more relaxed sessions, which will include Art, Computing and PE in the afternoons.

During SATs week, children will come to school at the usual time and we will provide an extra drink and a biscuit/fruit before the tests start. Please could you ensure that your child has a good night's rest and breakfast before coming to school each day.

The SATs results will state whether or not your child has met the 'expected standard' for a child in Y6 in the subjects tested. In your child's school report that will be sent home in July, there will be teacher assessment judgements as well as the SATs results.
