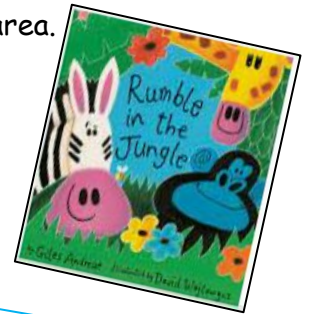
What a Wonderful World!
