In a few weeks we are going to go on a school trip to Filey. Draw or paint a picture of the seaside. You may need to search for a picture to inspire you!



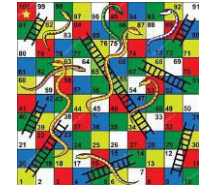
Find Filey on a map of the British Isles. Can you spot any other seaside resorts around the coastline? Make a list of them.
