Mathematics

We will focus on:

- Calculating change from £1, £2 and £5 by using our number bonds to 100 to help.
- Calculating the perimeter of a range of 2D shapes.
- Reading and telling the time to 1-minute intervals.
- Calculating periods of time.
- Recognise the properties of 3D shapes

History

In History we will learn about Henry VIII and the actions he took to try and have an heir to his throne.

We will learn about why he created the Church of England and finally what all this meant for Fountains Abbey.

English

We will start the half term by writing a non-chronological report about Fountains Abbey. We will learn what a non-chronological report is, read different examples and learn about the features of a non-chronological report.

We will then move on to write the ending to an adventure story using the book 'The Famous Five go off to Camp' as our inspiration.
