

Year 4 Parent/Carer - Summer Term 2

Science

In our science lessons, we will be looking at animals including humans. We will explore how teeth help animals to eat, what happens to food once we swallow it, as well as looking at the food chains from around the animal kingdom.

Music

We will be continuing our work with ukuleles, developing new skills and consolidating the skills we have learnt so far.

English Work

Our first English Big Write will be focused the legend, Beowulf. From this book, we will be making a character description about the main protagonist. We will then secure our knowledge of this book by writing our very own battle scene based on it.

French

The focus of our learning in French will be about the weather and then on food.

Religious Education

Following last half-term, we will be focusing on the first Guru in Sikhism - Guru Nanak. We will also be looking at some of the stories about him and their meaning.

History - Vikings

Following the chronology of our History lesson in Year 4, we will be exploring the end of the Anglo-Saxon rule in Britain and the Viking rule that followed. We will be developing our understanding of how the Vikings lived, if they were all warriors and savages and the effect they had on Britain at the time.

During this half term, the children will be taking part in Panathlon sport as well as using the OPAL equipment including scooters.

Mathematics

The children this half-term will be looking at money, using estimation, calculating and then solving money problems. After this, we move onto telling the time with hours, minutes and seconds, as well as a number of different shapes.

4L will be continuing their swimming lessons during the summer term. Both Year 4 classes will be using their cricket skills and use them in rounders games and activities.

Computing

In Computing, children will hone their computer science skills, creating things in 2Logo. From there, they will then move to improve their information technology skills with animation.
