### Parent/Carer drop ins

Every Thursday our Pastoral and family support worker, Sadie Kellett, is now offering informal parent/carers drop ins. Should you wish to speak to Mrs Kellett, please come to the main school office on a Thursday at 9.00am.

She can provide support on routines at home, behaviour strategies, signposting to external services, Early Help support, form filling, advice on promoting well-being at home and so much more.
