Dear Parents/Carers,

### **Useful Resources / Apps**

We appreciate that the Christmas season can be a hard time for some so wanted to signpost some services which may be of use.

- **'Shout'** is a free service which can be accessed by texting 85258 (free of charge, 24 hours per day).
  - This is the UK's first and only free, confidential, 24/7 text messaging service for anyone who is struggling to cope.
- **Kooth** is an 'online well-being community', which although only for 11-25 years olds, some of our older pupils or their older siblings may find useful. Here is the link should anyone want to explore this further. Home Kooth
- Pupils may well be spening more time online over the festive period, so we highly recommend you download the **National Online Safety** app. This is free of charge and provides lots of useful information on how to keep safe online.

#### **Attendance**

Although a Ping was sent yesterday with this information, a further reminder about attendance. As you will be aware, we follow Bradford Council procedures for attendance as we are obliged to do. At the end of the first 12 weeks of the school year, if a child's attendance is below 95%, you will receive a letter from us. We appreciate the letter reads quite formally (this is Bradford Council's wording) but the initial letter is nothing to panic about. We appreciate that, after only 12 weeks, one period of illness absence could result in attendance being below 95%. Furthermore, receiving a letter is not questioning the legitimacy of any absences.
