If your child is poorly and you need to report their absence, please make sure that you also let us know the specific reason they will be off, rather than a more general 'unwell'. This helps us to form a picture of any bugs in a particular area of school, or any illnesses that need reporting if a number of children fall ill with the same issue.

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## Uniform

Thank you for all the effort that has been made by parents and carers to send children into school in the correct PE kit after our previous request. Just to remind you, the school PE kit is as follows:

- Plain white t-shirt or with school logo
- Black or navy shorts or black or navy long track suit bottoms (plain blue or black leggings may also be worn)
- Leotards may be worn for indoor PE if preferred
- Black, navy or red sweatshirt (plain or with school logo)
- Trainers
- All items should be plain. Football kits etc. are not acceptable.
- Long hair must be tied up for PE and no jewellery should be worn. If your child wears earrings (only small studs allowed), please make sure your child can remove them or that they are not worn on PE days

If your child is in Key Stage 1 and has an after-school PE club, they may come to school in their PE uniform on that day. If your child is in Key Stage 2 and has a PE after-school club, they should come to school in their uniform and change at the end of the day (unless of course they have PE that day).
