

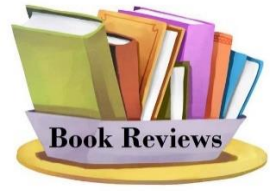
**Year 4 Spring 2**

- Your favourite part



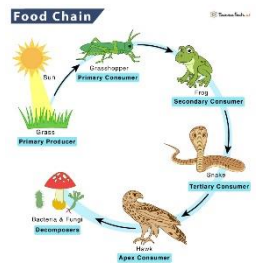
Do some research on what a typical Anglo-Saxon might wear. Can you design and outfit and label it?



In our history work, we have been continuing our studies on the Anglo-Saxons. In this term, we will look at 2 primary sources (Sutton Hoo and The Staffordshire Hoard). Can you draw your own version of some jewellery you may find from the Anglo-Saxon times?



As part of science exploration, we will be looking at how food chains work - can you research a food chain and illustrate it?



Research the height of various mountains in meters and walk the corresponding distance of one of them. Remember you will need to come back down again. For example, Ingleborough is 723 m, therefore you will need to walk 1,446 m to say you have walked the correct number of steps.



In Science we are learning about living things and their habitats. Can you visit a local park, hunting for mini beasts! Once you get back from the park, can you make a fact file about some of the creatures you found.



As part of our Geography, we are looking at Northern Ireland. Can you research some of the famous landmarks throughout the country?
