We will be receiving £10,000 from the Clean Air Schools Programme which we will be using to purchase bikes and scooters and also to pay for some cycling and scooting training. The aim is to set up a loan system for bikes so more pupils can travel to and from school using them.

We have been successful in a funding bid from the Wrose Community Association. The money received will be put towards an outdoor classroom (in the form of a yurt!) so that pupils can learn outside in all weather.
