Fine motor control

<u>Phonics</u>-Fred Talk. We will be listening to Fred's story and trying to blend the missing words. Try sounding out a CVC word and see if your child can guess what it is! E.g. /c/ /a/ /t/

We will learn how to write it and how to make the letter sound (phoneme).

Maths - Counting to 10 & Numerals 1-5.

Matching amounts to numerals. Can we find the correct numeral to represent amounts?

We will be looking at butterflies this week and the patterns on their wings. Can you paint and print a butterfly so the pattern is the same on both sides? Can you draw a pattern using dots, straight lines, wavy lines and zig zags?





Topic- Why are you so hungry Mr Caterpillar?

Discuss what has happened to our chrysalis'. What has emerged? Do they know the name of these butterflies? (Painted ladies)

Introduction to life cycles-


