Dashed – To move really quickly

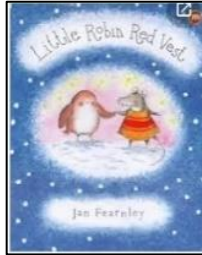
Move arms back and forth (like you are running)
