








Year 4 Half term 3
Suggested challenges for your child to enjoy at home

<p>Our class text is Room 13, can you draw and label what you think Room 13 looks like?</p> 	<p>Write a book review about a favourite text that you have read this half term. Comment on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The plot (Fiction) or subject (Non-Fiction) - Characters or key facts - Why you would recommend it? - Your favourite part 	<p>Design an Anglo-Saxon shield that could be worn during a battle. Do some research to find out the traditional style and then make your own.</p> 
<p>In PE we learning a dance linked to cats. Can you think of another animal that you would like to create a dance about. Think about how they move and what kind of music would represent them. Have a go at choreographing a dance for an animal e.g. penguin, elephant, snake.</p>	<p>Design and label or cook an Eastern European meal. There are lots of famous food cultures from this part of the world, so be careful with your research and don't forget to say which country each part is from!</p> 	<p>Lots of Eastern European countries take part in a famous competition called the 'Eurovision song contest'. Listen to some of the entries from over the years.</p> 
<p>In Science we are learning about electricity and how to use it safely. Create a poster to show what people should and shouldn't do in their homes to stay safe.</p> 	<p>As part of our geography, we are looking at Eastern Europe. Can you research a famous landmark/city in this area and make a fact file about this?</p> 	<p>In PSHE we will be thinking about appreciation. Think about what you have in life to be grateful for. How does it make you feel? Can you write a thank you letter to someone?</p>
