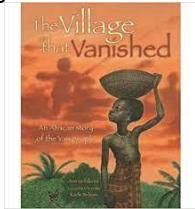


Year 4 Summer 1

Write a book review about a favourite text that you have read this half term. Comment on:

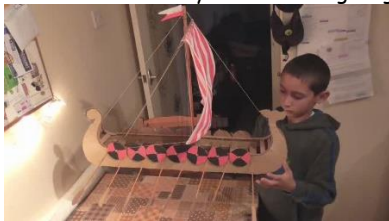
- The plot (Fiction) or subject (Non-Fiction)

We are looking at classifying animals in Science. Go on a minibeast hunt and classify the animals you find by counting the number of legs they have.



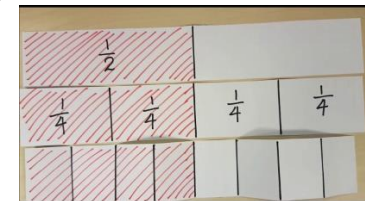
In our history we are learning about the Vikings. Use recycled materials to create your own Viking longboat.
