Suggested challenges for your child to enjoy at home

<b>PSHE</b> - Talk about what jobs family members do.	<b>History</b> - Spot the King's image on coins, stamps, and post boxes. Can you find Queen Elizabeth II too?	<b>Maths</b> - Count the petals on a flower—are they even or odd numbers?
<b>English</b> - Draw a Beatrix Potter-style animal using observation on a nature walk.	<b>Maths</b> - Fill a jar with small objects (beans, coins, LEGO) —can you estimate how many before counting?	<b>Science</b> - Leaf hunt: Collect different leaves and compare shape and size. Use this leaf identifier to help you <a href="#">Leaf identification for kids - Nature Detectives</a>
<b>Set up a pretend shop at home</b> using real or toy coins. Use household items or toys with simple price tags (e.g. 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p).	<b>Geography</b> - Look at a map and see how many different countries you can see in Europe.	<b>Maths</b> – Put some coins in order from the biggest to the smallest. Can you say their values too?
