Collect some leaves and either sketch them or do some rubbings using wax crayons. 	Listen to a piece of music and talk about which instruments you can hear. In Science, we are learning about forces and magnets. Our scientists of the unit are Leonardo da Vinci and Masato Sagawa. Can you find out some facts about them?	Help your adult to make a meal or enjoy baking some buns. Can you recall all the ingredients that you used and the order of the instructions? 	Go to the supermarket with your family. Write down the cost of 10 items. Can you order them from the least expensive to the most expensive? Challenge: find the total of 3 of these items.
