Suggested challenges for your child to enjoy at home

<p>Pick an expression of your choice. Create a portrait of this emotion using different materials (paint, crayon, chalk etc).</p> 	<p>Find a poem that you enjoy and read it. Talk to your adult about the words that are used. Read the poem out loud and perform it for your family.</p> 	<p>Go for a winter walk and talk about what you can see, hear, smell and feel.</p> 
<p>In History, we are learning about Ancient Egypt. Research some interesting facts. Present these however you'd like – the more creative, the better!</p> 	<p>Collect some leaves and either sketch them or do some rubbings using wax crayons.</p> 	<p>Listen to a piece of music and talk about which instruments you can hear. Can you discuss the pitch, tempo, rhythm, dynamics and texture? Present your findings to the class.</p> 
<p>In Science, we have been learning about different types of rocks. Create a poster explaining the difference between each type of rock.</p> 	<p>Help your adult to make a meal or enjoy baking some buns. Can you recall all the ingredients that you used and the order of the instructions?</p> 	<p>Go to the supermarket with your family. Write down the cost of 10 items. Can you order them from the least expensive to the most expensive? Challenge – find the total of 3 of these items.</p>
