Suggested challenges for your child to enjoy at home

Create an imaginary place you can visit!
Draw a picture of it and write some sentences using capital letters, finger spaces, and full stops.



We will be sending home different Phonics games for you to do at home to practice reading lots of different words in preparation for the phonics screening check. See what words you can read around your environment for example at home, street signs, while out shopping etc.

Practise your handwriting a little each day by carefully copying letters, words, or a short sentence using neat letter shapes and spaces. Remember your ascenders and descenders.



Draw a Beatrix Potter style animal and write a character description for it.



You could even draw your own alien and write an alien name for it.



Plant hunt: Go on a nature walk and see what trees and flowers you can spot. Can you identify them?



Set up a pretend shop at home using real or toy coins. Use household items or toys with simple price tags (e.g. 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p).



Create a poster, booklet or map exploring one of the 7 continents by finding facts for each! Include an extra focus on Europe because that's where we live!



Create your own "Maths Game" using addition and subtraction (e.g. a board game, card game, or spinner game) that someone at home can play with you!
